

**NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF WOMEN IN CONSTRUCTION (NAWIC) CHAPTER #341  
ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - LINN STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE  
SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The National Association of Women in Construction, Central Missouri Chapter #341, awards one \$500 annual scholarship to an individual pursuing a Certificate or Associate of Applied Science Degree in one of the following Linn State Technical College programs: Construction & Civil Technology, Commercial Turf and Grounds Management, Design Drafting Technology, Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning Technology or Heavy Equipment Operations. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based upon availability of funds.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be enrolled as a full-time (12 hours minimum per semester), first year or second year student.
- B. Applicant should be enrolled for the fall semester for the year in which the scholarship is awarded.
- C. Applicant should be a resident of Missouri.
- D. Applicant should be a student in good academic standing with a minimum 2.5 college or high school cumulative GPA. Or GED with 260 minimum score.
- E. Applicant should have the recommendation from a construction supervisor or technical course instructor.

### SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. To be considered, applicants must forward a complete application packet by the scholarship application deadline. Only scholarship finalists will be contacted for an interview by NAWIC Chapter #341 representatives. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based 50% upon the results of the applicant's interview, with the remaining 50% weighted equally based upon the following:
  - Work history related to construction trades.
  - Aptitude toward technical and construction related fields as demonstrated through academic achievement in related courses, vocational student organization involvement and skill competition results.
  - Ability to communicate clearly defined personal goals related to a career in the construction industry.
  - Recommendation of construction supervisor or technical instructor.
- B. Priority for Selection. This is a one time, annual scholarship. In the event a student is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester in the year the scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available alternate. Priority of selection is based upon an individual's general aptitude and personal traits that are viewed conducive to success in the construction field. Prior year recipients may reapply for scholarship; however, priority will be given to first-time applicants.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$500, which is applied directly to the recipient's account at Linn State Technical College in the fall semester upon the student's verified enrollment. The scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other cost associated with a student's education.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the next following academic year is **February 15**.

Please submit the following to be considered:

- Linn State Technical College Admissions Application.
- High school transcript, official GED score report or college transcript.
- ACT scores to Linn State Technical College (LSTC ACT Code: 5105), or take the COMPASS Test at the LSTC main campus.
- Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement and two character references) at [www.linnstate.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php](http://www.linnstate.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php).

## EXPECTATIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing.
- B. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available alternate.
- C. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to Linn State Technical College, the Foundation for Linn State Technical College and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s).
- D. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor scholarship winners and the recipient must send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.
