Circulation / Reference

The Circulation Desk is located near the entrance of the library, on the main floor of the Information Technology Center.
At the **Circulation** Desk, library books and other materials may be checked out, renewed, returned, etc. Questions about searching the library collection & databases can be answered by the staff at the **Reference** Desk.

Newspapers, magazines and scholarly **journals** are located in the current periodicals display area across from the Circulation Desk.

MOBIUS

MOBIUS is a consortium of 62 Missouri academic libraries. It also includes the Missouri State Library and two public libraries: Missouri River Regional Library and Springfield-Greene County Libraries.

Mobius provides access to more than 20 million items via a combined catalog and a state-wide delivery system.
